<u>Broadside: the Influence of Sea Power in History</u> is a documentary that tells the story of an English monarch, Charles II, leading his country into the fiercest trade war in the age of sail, and his Dutch adversary, Johann de Witt, a bold and able leader, whose untiring efforts saved the young Dutch republic from a war it could not win.
